

Pine Hollows Narrative

Leaving the Kentucky Artisan Center, turn left onto KY 595 and proceed to Interstate 75. Turn right onto I-75 North. Follow I-75 until it meets with I-64. Merge onto I-64 and travel east. Merge onto the Bert T Combs Mountain Parkway via exit 98.

Travel to Prestonsburg, KY. The parkway will turn into US 460. Continue straight and the road will turn into KY 114. Participant 1, **The Mountain Arts Center**, will be on your left-hand side. The Mountain Arts Center fuses music and culture into its family entertainment place. *Opened in 1996 and sitting along the "Country Music Highway", you will find a theater, meeting rooms, a recording studio, art gallery, and gift shop.* Continue on KY114. Turn left onto KY 23 North/460 West. Then turn right onto KY 1428. Follow the road until you see Participant 3, the **East Kentucky Science Center** on your left side. The East Kentucky Science Center features a brand new planetarium to the Eastern Kentucky area. The center seats eighty-five people and the Chronos Star Projector. *Laser light shows and live performances are part of the programming inside the planetarium.* Turn right to get back onto KY 1428 and left at the stoplight onto KY 23

South/460 East. Take the Prestonsburg exit and continue east on KY 114. Follow the road until it ends at a stoplight. Turn left to get on Highway 321. Follow until you see the large sign advertising StoneCrest Gold Course. Turn right onto Highway 3024 and follow the windy road. You will see a sign pointing straight for the public golf course. Follow the signs to the clubhouse and Participant 4, **StoneCrest Golf Course**. This golf course is maintained beautifully and is a spectacular course to play on .

You will also be able to view of up to fifty miles in every direction from the mountaintop of the course and clubhouse. Follow the windy road back to the main highway and turn left. You will be on 321 again. Follow this road straight into downtown Prestonsburg. Turn left onto Court Street and then right onto Central Avenue. Participant 5, the **Prestonsburg Visitor's Center** will be on the corner of those streets. The Prestonsburg Visitors Center is a great stop to plan your visits along the Appalachians, US 23, and the "Country Music Highway." This city offers horse shows, boating, water recreation, and civil war sites. *Famous musician Dwight*

Yoakam was born near Prestonsburg. Turn back onto Court Street and head back towards the main road. Instead of turning, continue straight through the stoplight. Follow the road until it ends and turn left onto Front Avenue. Participant 6, **Country at Heart and Old Town Fudge Company, Inc.** will be on your right side. Country at Heart and Old Town Fudge Company Inc. is famous among visitors and locals alike. Fudge is made fresh daily using only the finest ingredients. *You will also be able to purchase Kentucky crafts and gift items inside the store.* You will not be leaving downtown Prestonsburg and heading back towards US 23/460. Turn left on Fourth Street and then left again onto Arnold Avenue (one-way street). Make a right onto Friend Street and left onto



the main road. At the stoplight turn left onto KY 114 and continue straight ahead.

Merge onto KY 23 South/460 East and journey to Pikeville, KY. Take the downtown Pikeville exit to the right. Turn left off of the ramp and follow the road into downtown. When you see a blue train on the left turn left onto Huffman Avenue. You will see the office of Participant 9, **Pike County Tourism**, on the corner. The Pikeville Tourism Office will open your eyes to the natural surroundings of Eastern Kentucky's towering mountains. *Home to the annual "Hillbilly Days," you will also uncover great hiking trails, whitewater rafting, and diverse more outdoor activities to experience.* Turn left back onto the main road and continue straight. You will arrive at another exit for Pikeville ahead. Merge back onto KY 23 South/460 East. Travel to Elkhorn City, KY following 80 east. Merge right to stay on 80 and then you will merge left to stay on 80 after that. After passing the main

part of town, you will see a sign for the trailhead and Participant 10, **Pine Mountain Trail**, right after the police station and before the bridge. Pine Mountain Trail is located right on the border of Kentucky and Virginia is an adventure waiting to happen. The trail currently stretches for 28 miles and will be developed to extend 120 miles from Breaks Interstate Park to the Cumberland Gap National Park. *Pine Mountain was formed more than 275 million years ago.*

Continue on Hwy 80 East. Continue straight for approximately seven miles to the Kentucky and Virginia border. After entering Virginia, look for the signs for Participant 12, **Breaks Interstate Park**. Turn right to enter the main entrance to the park. Breaks Interstate Park features a canyon that stretches over five miles long and 1600

feet deep and sits on the border of Kentucky and Virginia. The park features miles and miles of hiking trails and four scenic overlooks. *Breaks Interstate Park is home to the biggest canyon east of the Mississippi.* Turn left out of the park and head West on Highway 80. When you get into the main part of Elkhorn City, KY, turn left onto Highway 197 and head South. You will be traveling to Jenkins, KY. When the road ends at the stop sign, turn left onto Highway 805. After passing Burdine, KY you will come to Jenkins. On the right side in a train depot is Participant 14, **David Zegeer Coal and Railroad Museum**. Inside you will unearth a fine collection of photographs, artifacts, and scrip from the coal-mining town of Jenkins,



KY. *David Zeeger Coal-Railroad Museum is housed in a train depot built back in 1911.* Turn right onto Hwy 805 to continue past Jenkins. You will come to the junction of 805 and US 23/460. Continue straight to travel to Seco, KY. There will be a green sign on the right pointing towards Seco. Turn right and travel down the hill and across the one-lane bridge. Merge to the left towards the town center. Turn right onto Seco Drive and to your left is Participant 15, the **Old SECO Country Store and Bed and Breakfast**. This participator features a winery, catering business, and accommodations. Interior designs highlight a mix of period furnishings and each room in furnished with a private bath. *The company store was built in the 1900's.* Make your way back to Highway 805 and turn left. When you get to the junction of 805 and US 23/460, turn left to head north/west. Continue on US 23 North/460 West back towards Prestonsburg, KY. Take the exit for the Jenny Wiley State Park. Turn right off the exit ramp. You will be traveling on Highway 302. Proceed straight and watch for the park signs. The road will take you right into the park. Participant 7, **Jenny Wiley State Park** will be on both sides and Participant 8, **Jenny Wiley Theater** will be on the right side. Jenny Wiley

State Resort and Theater sits right along the 1100-acre Dewey Lake. A state park, Jenny Wiley presents an outdoors-musical theater, hiking trails, golf, and superior accommodations. *Ride the sky lift to the top of Sugar Camp Mountain to* get off at exit 77. Turn left onto 595 and then right in the center. *observe the overview of the park.* To visit the last participant of the Pine Hollow Trail, return to US 23 North/460 West to Prestonsburg. Get off the Prestonsburg exit and turn left onto KY 114. After passing the Mountain Arts Center, you will come to KY 404 on your left side. Turn left and follow the road to Participant 2, **David Appalachian Crafts**, on your left side. David Appalachian Crafts is a non-profit organization that preserves the pristine artwork of the Appalachian community. *Participants craft patchwork quilts, dolls, woodwork, and baskets.* To finish your trip at the Kentucky Artisan Center in Berea, travel back to KY 114 to continue west back to the Mountain Parkway. The

Mountain Parkway will merge back onto I-64 South. Take I-64 South to I-75 South and then
